

**CODE OF PRACTICE FOR NOISE CONTROL ON
CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION SITES**

AMENDMENT NO. 1

January 1999

1. **Page 6, Clause 1(b)**
Delete "if allowed to do so, given the special permission required in such cases." At the end of this clause.
2. **Page 11, Clause 15**
 - a) In paragraph 2, *add* "On-site power generators should not be used if external power can be supplied to the construction site." at the end of this clause.
 - b) In paragraph 4, *replace* "Site subsoil conditions should be thoroughly investigated in order to consider methods of working which minimize site noise and reduce the possibility of changes in working caused by meeting unforeseen circumstances." *with* "Site subsoil conditions should be thoroughly investigated in order to consider the most appropriate piling methods to be used to ensure that the piling noise is kept to a minimum."
3. **Page 12, Clause 15**
In paragraph 5, *add* "The following should be located away from nearby residential premises: access road to the site, truck washing bay, site office, temporary living quarters if any, on-site power generators if external power is not available." at the end of this clause.
4. **Page 12, Section 16**
In paragraph 2, *add* "This should include noise measurement, recording and noise monitoring instruments." at the end of this clause.
