#### 1. Page 4, Foreword

Part 2 : 1988 Circular sawing machines (sawing machines with rotating tools)

### 2. Page 5, Subclause 2.2

Delete the year "1973" in the sentence.

# 3. Page 5, Subclause 2.8

*Insert* the following text:

(d) Reference should be made to the Factories (Noise) Regulations, 1996 for the control and prevention of noise hazards.

### 4. Page 9, Subclause 4.2.1

(a) *Insert* the following text after the first sentence:




Figure 1(a) - Self-adjusting guard for small sawing machines with blade up to 300 mm diameter

A power feed could be used to reduce the risk of contact with the saw blade (see Figure 1(a)).

- (b) Insert Figure 1(a) (see attached) before Figure 1 on Page 10.
- (c) Replace the text "(see Fig. 1)" in the fourth paragraph with "(see Figure 1(b))".
- (d) *Insert* the following text after the last sentence in the fourth paragraph:

The width of the push-stick is dependent on the worker's palm size and the size of the workpiece. It should be designed to withstand the force when in use.

### 5. **Page 10, Figure 1**

Replace and re-number the diagram as "Figure 1(b)" (see attached).

# 6. Page 29, Subclause 5.1.1

(a) Amend the first sentence of the subclause as follows:

No person shall be ... with the use of the machines and the precautions to be observed; and ...

(b) Insert the word "or" after Subclause 5.1.1 (a).

# 7. Page 29, Subclause 5.1.3

Insert the following text after the first sentence:

This instruction and other safety measures shall be written in languages understood by persons employed at such machine and be displayed on such machine or at a place nearest to the process.

## 8. Page 37

Insert after this page the list of standards referred to in CP 42.




Figure 1(b) - Push stick
