### SPECIFICATION FOR REFINED AND DEODORIZED SOYA BEAN OIL

#### **FOREWORD**

This Singapore Standard was drawn up by the Technical Committee on Edible Fats and Oils under the direction of the Food Standards Committee.

It is a revision of SS 135: 1975 on Specification for Refined, Bleached and Deodorized Soya Bean Oil. The standard resulted in major changes to the technical requirements in the standard in line with international requirements and trade practices.
