It is a revision of SS 62: 1976 - Specification for Carbonated and Non-carbonated Beverages. The revision resulted in major changes to the technical requirements in the standard in line with international requirements and trade practices.

1. SCOPE

This specification prescribes the requirements and the methods of test of non-alcoholic carbonated and non-carbonated beverages which are intended for consumption without dilution. It does not cover diabetic and dietetic drinks, natural mineral waters, milk and milk products and soya bean drink.
