SS 62 : 1997

1. SCOPE

This specification prescribes the requirements and the methods of test of non-alcoholic carbonated and non-carbonated beverages which are intended for consumption without dilution. It does not cover diabetic and dietetic drinks, natural mineral waters, milk and milk products and soya bean drink.
