## What we do

The Biomedical Standards Committee, under the Singapore Standards Council, pioneers the development and promotion of standards in the healthcare and biomedical science industries in Singapore.

Under our purview, various Technical Committees and Working Groups are formed. They actively monitor and participate in the development and review of international standards that are of importance to Singapore, including those pertaining to new technologies and in emerging industries. These committees are instrumental in encouraging organisations to adopt best practices that will enhance safe usage of medical devices and materials.

As a national standards body, SPRING Singapore administers the Singapore Standardisation Programme under the guidance of an industry-led Singapore Standards Council.
